#### Illinois Confidentiality & Minor Consent Laws

## PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT EXCEPTIONS

A parent or legal guardian must provide consent on behalf of a minor (under age 18) before health care services are provided, with several important exceptions.<sup>i</sup>

- **Emergency care** •
- Care for pregnant or parenting minors •
- Care for emancipated minors .
  - Minors can be emancipated by: court order, marriage, military active duty
- Specific health care services related to:
  - Sexual health
  - Mental health
  - Substance use treatment

Patients ages 12 and up have the right to the following <u>WITHOUT</u> parental/guardian consent:

- Pregnancy testing and prenatal care<sup>ii</sup>
- Birth control information and contraceptives<sup>iii</sup>
- Abortions<sup>iv</sup>
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV, HPV, and PrEP<sup>v</sup>
- Substance use treatment<sup>vi</sup>
- Mental health counseling\*vii

\* Up to eight, 90-minute mental health counseling sessions for ages 12-16. Minors can access more than eight sessions if the provider believes it's in the minor's best interest to continue or that parental involvement would be detrimental to the minor's well-being.

## MINORS NEED A PARENT/GUARDIAN'S CONSENT FOR:

- Inpatient mental health treatment (if under • age 16; after age 16, consent is not needed but parents may receive notification)viii
- Vaccines (except HPV) ix
- Psychotropic medication (including medication for treatment of depression)<sup>x</sup>

# HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS MUST OVERRIDE THE MINOR'S CONFIDENTIALITY AND REPORT IF:

- There is suspicion of abuse by an adult
- The minor is a risk to themselves or . someone else

If maximum confidentiality is important to an adolescent, then community-based family planning health centers (such as Title X clinics) offer the maximum privacy protections.
